Mandatory and recommended personal equipment of the competitors.

battle dress uniform with boots	mandatory
backpack	mandatory
rations for three (3) days	mandatory
personal first aid kit and whistle	mandatory
throwing knife or bayonet	mandatory
water bottle or some other container	mandatory
standard automatic or semiautomatic rifle	mandatory
14 live rounds for the rifle	mandatory
2 magazines for the rifle	mandatory
90 blank cartridges for the rifle	mandatory
pistol or revolver	mandatory
2 magazines for the pistol	mandatory
16 live rounds for pistol/revolver	mandatory
3 sets of earplugs	mandatory
compass	mandatory
safety rope (15m, 400 kg capacity)	mandatory
10 battle noise simulators	mandatory
spare combat boots	recommended
spare underwear, socks	recommended
ground sheet	recommended
utensils for personal hygiene	recommended
dishes	recommended
matches	recommended

Important!

The weigh and amount of equipment is not limited. Teams can have additional equipment. It will be checked and if it is not consumable during the competition (food etc), it has to be carried along until finish.

Cell phones and pagers are not allowed.

Night vision devices and GPS devices are allowed.

AFTER THE DRAW OF START ORDER EVERY TEAM GETS A NUMBER. THIS NUMBER HAS TO BE MARKED ON EVERY ELEMENT OF EQUIPMENT. UNDERWEAR AND FOOD PACKAGES INCLUDED. THE NUMBER IS CHECKED IN EQUIPMENT CHECK. IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR IDENTIFYING LOST PROPERTY.

Mandatory equipment for the team:

1. first aid kit that will be checked by medics at starting point
2. tent that stays in the camp
3. inflatable boat with oars for 4 (four) persons
4. four (4) life jackets
5. flare gun with four (4) red flares

“Erna” society does not give out equipment for Estonian teams. We understand the problems of transportation for the foreign teams and the priority is their needs.

NB! The team can not participate if not properly manned or lacking:

- A. weapons
- B. ammunition
- C. rations for 3 days
- D. first aid kit
- E. inflatable boat
- F. radio (given by the competition staff)
- G. safety rope
- H. life-jackets

Pyrotechnics and ammunition used by the organizers:

- A. illuminating rockets
- B. high trajectory signal rockets (red and green)
- C. battle-noise simulators
- D. electrical detonators
- E. blank cartridges
