1. SITUATION

a. General

(1) The international long range reconnaissance (LRR) competition ERNA RAID 2006 will be traditionally held on the first week of AUGUST, 2006. Approximately 30 teams are participating.

b. Legend

(1) Enemy forces

Since XX XXXX JUL 2006, the enemy forces (ENEMY FORCES, ENFOR) have taken control over the most of the territory which is assigned as the area of responsibility of own forces (FRIENDLY FORCES, FRIENFOR) recce company (RECCOY).

Battalion-size ENFOR mechanized recce unit, supported by helicopters has been located in strongpoints, on the bigger roads and in settlements there are continuously patrolling platoon-size (recce) units with the probable mission to initiate battle contact with the possible enemy (ERNA teams) in order to take prisoners or destroy the enemy (collect the so-called life-tickets, real physical contact is not allowed). On the key terrain (open areas) there are placed concealed and disguised observation posts. Night vision gear is used, especially in air recce.

The "fifth column" is co-operating with ENFOR and controlling continuously all major roads and settlements by immobile and/or mobile patrols.

In the woodland areas there may be hiding armed groups deserted from ENFOR units.

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In phase I of the mission

There are no enemy activities to be expected in the landing area (except the show for spectators); the ENFOR activities against the LRR patrols will be agile south from TALLINN – NARVA highway, surveillance helicopters are expected to be around, especially at night and that is expected to occur also during the landing.

(2) Friendly forces (FRIENFOR)

SINIMAA (BLUELAND) armed forces are regrouping after heavy battles with the enemy (ENFOR) as the enemy's attack is stopped and there is a break in fighting. Friendly forces are holding a defence line MAARDU-ARUKÜLA-KEHRA-ARDU.

In the harbours and airports on SINIMAA (BLUELAND) western coast arrangements are made to welcome treaty forces whose arrival is planned not before 05AUG2006.

(a) The task organisation

- 1) ERNA 2006 teams (LRR groups of 4 members)
- 2) ERNA 2006 search and rescue (SAR) teams and medical support
- 3) FRIENFOR contact persons in operational area (ERNA 2006 CP personnel and umpires)

c. Environment

(1) Terrain

In addition to the information given in competition instructions special attention should be paid to different water bodies and relief.

2. MISSION

The recce company (RECCOY) of the FRIENFOR collects and delivers all the information about enemy's location, nature and activities during 4-day operation (D+4), moving in disguise and dissipated along the terrain in 4-men LRR groups. They are also to perform additional tasks (in ERNA 2006 checkpoints).

3. EXECUTION

The intent of the higher commander is to collect and analyze all possible information about the enemy's (CAF) dislocation, strength, weaponry, transportation and activities on the ERNA 2006 operational area.

In order to complete the higher commander's tasks, the LRR patrols will be transported from the Assembly Area (AA) in TALLINN to the BAY of KOLGA (07 97). After the landing operation the LRR patrols are to move by foot from SALMISTU (06 96) to KAUTLA (11 55). The contact persons (umpires in CP's) on the operational area may give the LRR patrol additional tasks.

a. Concept of operations

- i. The completion of the tasks is supposed to be divided into the phases
- ii. The LRR Company is divided into 4-men LRR patrols
- iii. After the completion of the tasks, the LRR patrols will be evacuated at the determined time (timetable will be included at the mandate) and place (KAUTLA) by (virtual) helicopters.

b. Restrictions

- i. There are approximately 30 LRR patrols in the operational area, in order to avoid LRR patrols activities by the CAF it is not allowed to have any contacts to other patrols and cooperation with them during the operation
- ii. Movements by roads which are drawn "twoline" on the 1:50 000 map are not allowed in order not to be detected by CAF

4. SERVICE SUPPORT

- a. During the preparations to the competitions all LRR patrols (teams) are responsible for equipment and support themselves

5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL

a. Location of ERNA 2006 Head Quarter

- i. until 011200AUG2006: TOOMPEA 8, TALLINN
- ii. after 011200AUG2006: ERNA 2005 HQ, KAUTLA

b. During arrangements use civil communication networks (see ANNEX H)

c. In the course of the competition standard signal procedures

d. Due to the security reasons, the E3 section of the HQ monitors the forward motion of teams on terrain by GPS sensors, using of which is obligatory.

The CAF will NOT be given such a information, and it will not be used for planning of the counteraction activities.

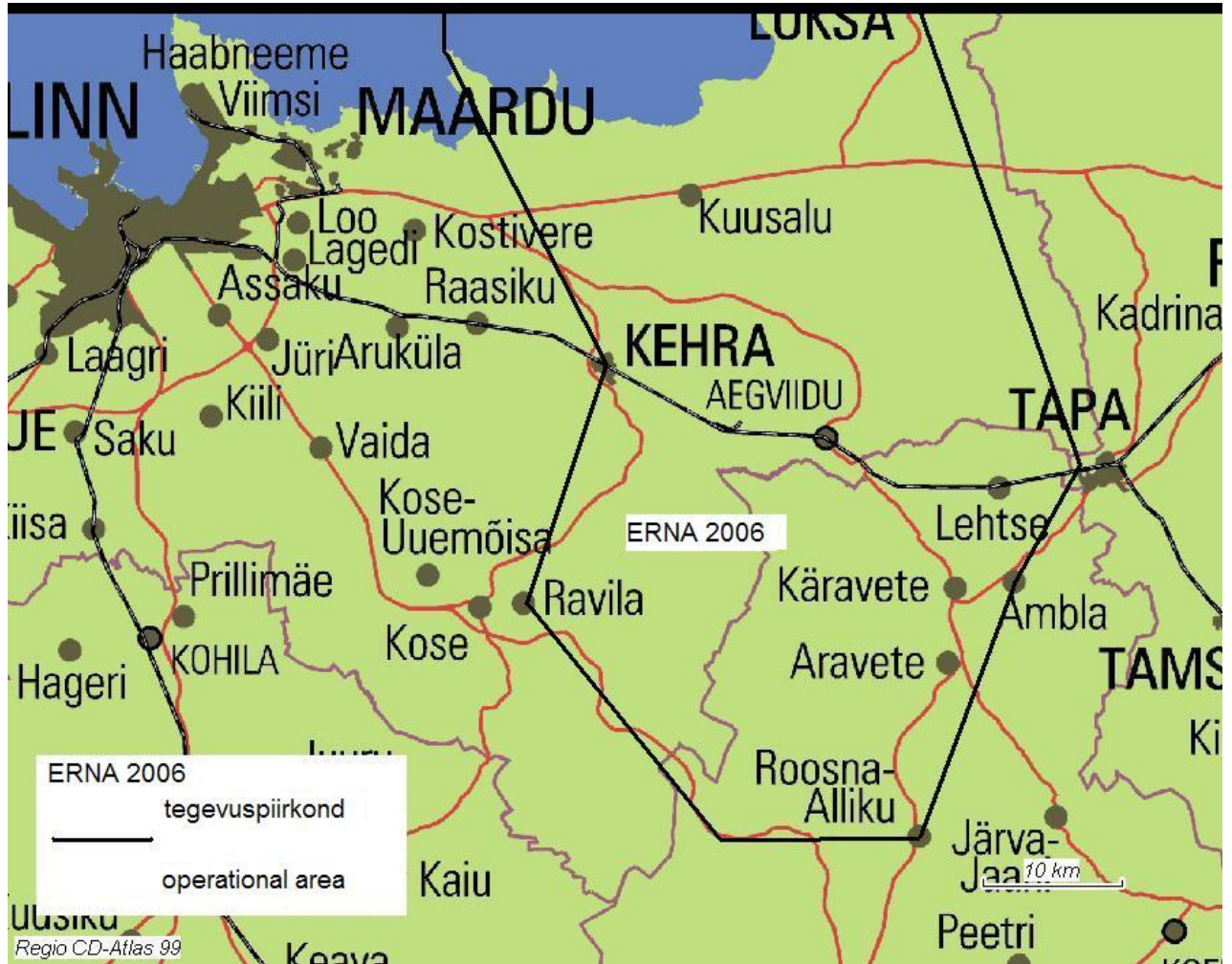
